Part of the Pristina upgrade included the much anticipated "set your own compression" feature, called the Dueta. Imaging for Women was the first imaging center in the United States to have this installed! This has been a game changing feature for many patients. Not only are patients saying the overall experience with Pristina and Dueta is much improved compared to prior years, we are finding that patients are more likely to apply more compression when they are in control. This extra compression improves the quality of the exam decreasing the amount of radiation that the patient receives as well as making blurring less likely. It really is a win-win situation for us and our patients.

We would like to take a moment to thank all of you who refer your patients to us here at IFW and allow us to be a part of their health care team. Our goal is to provide patients with the best care possible while keeping the costs affordable for all. We continue to be the best value for patients who need diagnostic breast imaging or a breast biopsy. In some cases, the cost for us to perform a breast biopsy is up to 80% less than having it done in a hospital setting. And with deductibles only looking to rise in the future, that is a huge savings to patients.
