

In fact, 70% of breast cancers occur in dense breasts (Ann Surg Onc, 2010). IFW Expands Automated Whole Breast Ultrasound



Although the weather can't make up its mind, we at Imaging for Women are moving on with spring plans. We have now installed a second Automated Whole Breast Ultrasound unit to help better accommodate the growing number

of patients who wish to have this additional screening tool performed while they are in the office. As women and their providers learn more about breast density and the limitations of mammography alone for dense tissue, more and more patients are requesting Automated Whole Breast Ultrasound. With a second unit, we will be able to more quickly perform the same day examination and screen more patients. At Imaging for Women, this helps us find 2.6 more cancers per thousand patients. <u>Digital</u> <u>Breast</u> <u>Tomosynthesis</u>

A recent study in the American Journal of Roentgenology reports that "Adding digital breast tomosynthesis (DBT) to digital mammography improves breast cancer screening in women younger than 50, decreasing recalls and finding more cancers in those who have dense breast tissue." This is an important development in the discussion on the benefits of routine annual screening beginning at age 40.
