GET THE FACTS!

- 40 is the age at which women should start getting annual mammograms.
- 37% reduction in breast cancer deaths since mammography screening became widespread in 1990.
- 1 in 6 breast cancers occur in women ages 40-49.
- A woman has about a 1 in 8 chance of being diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime, according to the National Cancer Institute.
- 3 out of 4 women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history of the disease.
- Another top risk factor for breast cancer: simply getting older. As you age, your risk of breast cancer goes up — most breast cancers are found in women age 55 and older.
- Thanks to new treatments and early detection, the five-year relative survival rate for women with breast cancer is about 90%!!!
- Women with dense breasts (more glandular and fibrous tissue and less fatty tissue) on mammograms have a risk of breast cancer that is about 1.5 to 2 times that of women with average breast density.
